What is IOS?

iOS (originally iPhone OS) is a mobile operating system created and developed by Apple Inc. and distributed exclusively for Apple hardware. It is the operating system that presently powers many of the company's mobile devices, including the iPhone, iPad, and iPod touch.

Now scroll down and find the app you want then tap it to open it to give more details. You will get a full description of what the app does and towards the bottom it will state if free or paid.

There are plenty of free apps available so before buying an app make sure there is not one that is free.
