

How to Use Bookmarks on the iPad

Make sure that the page you want to bookmark is open, and then tap the Share button at the top of the screen (right hand side of address bar).

A drop down box appears with lots of actions. Tap Add Bookmark.

A new window opens with a default name for the bookmark, its web address, and its folder location.

To accept the default bookmark name and default bookmark folder, tap Save.

To change the default bookmark name, tap the X in the circle next to the name, enter the new title (using the virtual keyboard), and then tap Save.

To open a bookmarked page after you set it up, tap the Bookmarks icon in the upper-left portion of the screen. If the bookmark you have in mind is buried inside a folder, tap the folder name first and then tap the bookmark you want. If you see History or Reading List instead of Bookmarks, tap the Bookmarks button at the top of the list and then tap the appropriate bookmark.
